- wants to go to both college and university?

Ontario's **postsecondary transfer & pathway system** may be the answer your students are looking for.

Unfortunately, many students aren't aware of their transfer & pathway options.

- understand transfer & pathways, how they work & the benefits they provide to students
- explore their transfer options so they can make more empowered postsecondary decisions



What is transfer?

Transfer — when a student switches from one postsecondary program/school to another.

Pathway — defined transfer route from one postsecondary program to another program.

There are 2 types of transfer:

Program Pathway — transfer a block of credits/courses from one program to another.

Course Transfer — transfer individual courses a student has already completed.

Or, a student can take a course at another school & have it apply towards their current school.

*Course transfers may only be relevant for students after they start an undergraduate program.

How do transfer & pathways benefit students?

65,000+

transfer students in any given year in Ontario.

Transfer & pathways allow students to:

- access alternative entry points into a program/school they were not initially accepted to
- change programs or switch schools if/when their personal/financial circumstances, interests or education goals change
- combine certificates, diplomas & degrees to increase their chances at career success

Quick Fact

Depending on the type of transfer or pathway, a student may receive credits for their previously completed studies.



Students who are able to carry over previously earned credits avoid starting their new program from scratch.

E.g. A student is awarded "advance standing" in their new program.

Why should high school students know about transfer & pathways?

Many high school students are unaware of their transfer & pathway options when deciding which postsecondary program or school to apply to.



Helping your students understand their options can:

- ease their postsecondary concerns
- empower them to make the most informed postsecondary choices possible
- educate them on alternative opportunities that can help meet their postsecondary goals
